

Prepare at Least 3 Days' Worth of the Following

- ♦ Drinking Water
- 3 liters per day \times
- 3 days
- =9 liters

(per person)



♦ Food

Food that do not require cooking (Canned / instant food etc.)



- ♦ Emergency toilet sets
- $5 \text{ per day} \times 3 \text{ days}$
- =15 sets

(per person)


